CONGRESS DATES AND LOCATION

June 11 – 14, 2028

Vancouver Convention Centre (VCC)

The main venue for the Congress, the award winning Vancouver Convention Centre located on the stunning Vancouver downtown waterfront, will provide attractive and ample space for delegates and exhibitors. The spacious VCC East Exhibit Hall will serve as the central hub, hosting exhibitors, poster presentations, and a series of networking events, including the welcome reception and daily coffee breaks and lunches. Vancouver is a vibrant, safe, and walkable city, and in addition to the scientific program and the large commercial exhibition, there will be a wide range of events in and outside the VCC, providing varied opportunities for company representatives to mix and interact in-person with the delegates during the four days of the Congress.

To enable a high level of interaction, the number of exhibit booths will be limited.
